Middle and high school students (6th to 12th graders) are invited to submit a piece of artwork which will be displayed from 2 to 7 pm on Saturday, July 17th (rain date: Sunday, 7/18) in Ballard Park while bands are competing. Celebrity judges will award prizes and event goers will be invited to vote for their favorite piece. Up to three cash awards will be presented that day. ELIGIBILITY:

- Rhode Island middle and high school students (6th - 12th grades).
- Each artist may enter one work executed during the year.
- Works on paper or canvas including pen & ink, drawings, paintings, photographs and lithographs are acceptable up to 18" x 24" in size.
- All works will be hung outside with clips on clothesline so they should not be too heavy or framed.
- Each work must be clearly labeled on the front with the artist's name, title and medium. FBP will provide a label at drop off.
- Friends of Ballard Park (FBP) will not insure work.
- Artists must pick up their work on Wednesday July 21st or Thursday July 22nd. Works not picked up become the property of FBP and may be sold to benefit the organization.
- FBP may deny entry of art if subject matter is not appropriate for the family-oriented Molly Finn Battle of the Bands.

SCHEDULE:

Drop off artwork: Wednesday, July 7th from 11 to 5 pm or Thursday, July 8th from 11 to 5 pm at FBP, 226 Bellevue Avenue, Room 10 (2nd Floor)

Exhibit: Saturday, July 17th. 2 to 6 pm at Ballard Park. Rain date: 7/18 - 2 to 6 pm

Awards: Three awards will be presented during the 4th Annual Molly Finn Battle of the Bands between 3:30 and 5:00 pm. People's Choice Award will be presented between 6 and 7 pm

Pick Up: Work **MUST** be picked up on Tuesday, July 20 or Wednesday, July 21st between 11 - 5 pm at FBP, 226 Bellevue Avenue, Room 10 (2nd Floor).
Uncollected works become the property of Friends of Ballard Park and may be sold to benefit programming.
